FEE WAIVER:

- 1. The applicants of the following category shall be exempted from the Tuition Fee
 - a. Students securing more than 90 % marks in the qualifying exam such as Graduation
 - b. Wards of Martyrs
 - c. Wards of family demised in natural calamity
 - d. Wards of residents of village adopted by the University
- 2. The tuition fee and other fees shall be such as prescribed by the University.
- 3. In case of an applicant form the ward of University employee or the applicants belonging to any of the following categories, the available seats in the subject concerned may be increased up to 20% of the total seats available. The distribution of these 20% surplus seats, shall be as given below
 - a. 50% Sponsored/In-service Candidates
 - b. 25% Foreign/NRI students
 - c. 25% MGSU Employee's wards (These candidates, however, shall appear in the Entrance Exam)
