# I. Sports Activities:

- a) Tug the war (boys and girls)
- b) Long Jump
- c) Race 100 meters
- d) Race 200 meters
- e) Triple Jump

#### **II. Cultural Activities:**

#### 1. MUSIC

- a) **Vocal Solo:** Duration of performance 3 minutes.
- b) Classical Instrumental Solo: Duration of performance 3 minutes (3minutes for instrument setting extra)
- c) **Group Song:** Duration of performance 3 minutes. (Maximum five singers)

#### 2. DANCE

- a) Classical Group Dance (Indian): Duration of performance 3 minutes.
- b) Classical solo Dance (Indian): Duration of performance 3 minutes.
- c) Classical duet Dance (Indian): Duration of performance 3 minutes.

#### III. LITERARY EVENTS

#### Debate

- a) Each College will be represented by the two participants, one will speak FOR, while another will speak AGAINST the motion.
- b) Medium of the debate will be in Hindi or in English.
- c) Topics of the Debate will be given on the spot.
- d) Each speaker will be allowed to speak for maximum 3 minutes.

#### IV. THEATRE

- (A) Skit (Maximum ten minutes time, 10 candidates)
- a) Only one team per College will be allowed.
- b) Maximum number of participants allowed is six.
- c) Maximum time allotted for each team is 8 minutes.
- d) Use of make-up, drapery and background music is allowed. No personal remarks, aspersions, character assassination, *etc*, is allowed.
- e) The presentation will be judged basically on the qualities like theme, work on acting, stage craft, design and general impression.

- f) Vulgarity or bitter insinuations in presentation should be avoided. Only innocent *satire* or humour is expected.
- (B) Mimicry
- a) Each participant shall be given 3 minutes.
- b) Participants may mimic sound of machines and speeches of well-known persons etc. including film personalities

#### V. FINE ARTS:

- (a) Rangoli
  - a) Duration will not be more than 45 minutes
  - b) Participants shall bring their own material.
  - c) The participants shall have to prepare a rangoli within the space provided by the organizer.

# **IMPORTANT**

- The participants are requested to study the rules and regulations for the various events given above.
- The decision of the Judges appointed for different events shall be final and binding upon all.
- Minimum 4 entries shall be required for conduction of any single event.

# **Rules and Regulations**

# A. Eligibility Rules

- 1. Only *bonafide*, full time regular student, who is enrolled for a degree or post graduate degree or diploma course which is of a minimum duration of one academic year and whose examination is conducted by the University subsequent to passing the 12<sup>th</sup> class examination.
- 2. A student who is **less than 25 years of age as on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2018** shall be eligible for participating in the ICCC Activities.
- 3. A working student employed on full time basis shall not be eligible to participate.

# B. Disqualification for violation of Eligibility Rules

Any disqualification of a participant on ground of ineligibility will result in the automatic removal of the contingent for that academic year. The contingent shall also be debarred from participating in such activities to be held in the following years.

# C. Strength of Contingent

Maximum number of participants allowed to take part in the events of the festival is **30** per College.

#### D. Contingent In-charge

Participating College shall send a maximum of two persons as contingent In-charge, who will maintain a liaison with the organizing committee of the host University. Lady contingent leader is essential for girl participants. Officials will be excluded in the contingent of 30.

### E. Identity Card

Identity Cards with photographs signed by the appropriate authorities of the respective College should be carried by the participants.

#### F. Travelling Expenses

The participating College will have to bear the travelling expenses.

### **G. ICCC Committee**

The host University would form various sub-committees for the smooth conduct of the ICCC which would function under a Standing Committee. The sub-committees may include Reception, Transport, Infrastructure Program, Publicity, Inaugural / Valedictory. There would also be a **Control Room** to control the festival activities.

#### H. Costumes

The costume selected by the participant shall be their own (will not be provided by the hosts) and should not be vulgar in any sense and should be under the supervision of the contingent leader.

# I. Discipline

- If the behavior of any contingent is found contrary to the objectives of the ICCC, the host University may take suitable action against the concerned member(s) and the individual(s) / team be debarred from participation in the future youth festivals for three years under intimation to the AIU.
- 2. No official or any member from any college shall go to the press on any controversial issue. The consumption of liquor, smoking, eve teasing, influencing the adjudicators, indecent behavior inside the campus and venue and at the place of stay is strictly prohibited. Those violating this clause shall be liable to disciplinary action which may be to the extent of debarring the concerned College/Team from participation in the Inter College Cultural Competition for a period as may be determined by the ICCC Cultural Committee.

## J. Stamp Size Photos

Two passport sized photographs of each participant, accompanist and official delegate are required to be sent to the host University in advance.
